

CERTIFICATE COURSE IN COMPETITION LAW

The School of Competition Law and Market Regulation, IICA, inaugurated its *Certificate Course in Competition Law* on October 10, 2014 at Scope Complex, New Delhi. The certificate programme is aimed at students as well working professionals and practitioners seeking career in the field of Competition Law. The School has been able to register **41 entries** representing a heterogeneous group of young lawyers, in-house counsels, officials from public and private sector enterprises and students from various academic backgrounds of law and economics.

The inauguration programme started with the welcome address and brief description of the course given by **Dr. Navneet Sharma**, Head, School of Competition Law and Market Regulation, IICA. At the inauguration ceremony, **Mr. Dhanendra Kumar**, Former Chairperson, Competition Commission of India (CCI) & Principal Advisor, IICA, threw light on the meaning of competition law for different stakeholders. **Mr. Manoj Kumar Sinha**, Director, Indian Law Institute (ILI), was the guest of honour and **Mr. Ashok Chawla**, Chairperson, CCI was the chief guest of the event.

Dr. Bhaskar Chatterjee, DG & CEO, IICA introduced candidates to the mandate of IICA and spoke of the need for gaining expertise in the field of law and economics to understand the basics of Competition Law. The inauguration was followed by two days of classroom sessions which covered the fundamentals of law and economics using illustrative case studies. Six sessions spread over the period of two days witnessed the presence of various resource persons representing law firms, the CCI, MNCs, etc. giving practical exposure to candidates in the field of competition law.
