

“Round Table Consultation on Integrated Reporting” on 23rd November, 2011

The integrated reporting framework created by the International Integrated Reporting Committee (IIRC) is the first global framework for integrated reporting. Apart from IIRC, GRI, Prince of Wales project on Accounting for Sustainability (A4S) and others are making efforts to popularize the discipline around the world. IIRC has released a discussion paper titled **“Towards Integrated reporting: Communicating Value in the 21st Century”** seeking views of the stakeholders from all over the world.

The Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA) was tasked by Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India to lead the initiative of compilation of views from various stakeholders through a nationwide consultation process in collaboration with Institute of Cost & Works Accountants of India (ICWAI). Accordingly IICA and ICWAI conducted a **“Round Table Consultation on Integrated Reporting” on 23rd November, 2011 at Tagore Hall, Scope Convention Centre, CGO Complex, New Delhi.** Ms. Matty Yates, Head of International Network, The Prince’s Accounting for Sustainability Project (A4S), UK was invited to make a presentation on the topic. Mr. M. Gopalakrishnan, President, ICWAI, Mr. Bhaskar Chatterjee, DG, IICA, Mr. Sudhir Mital, IAS, Additional Secretary to Government of India, Ministry of Corporate Affairs were also present at the event.
